Did you know? ... your donations are helping schools prepare for volcanic eruptions in the Democratic Republic of Congo. "When the volcano erupted, it was totally unexpected," reflects schoolteacher Birindwa, remembering the devastating volcanic eruption that hit Goma. "No one knew which direction to go in. There was no alert from the government." The school now take part in evacuation drills, siren sounds and the older students take the younger children by the hand, guiding them along the two-mile route to a safe evacuation site. The evacuation drill is part of a CAFOD project in Goma that has supported 60 schools, along with a hospital, disability centre and a marketplace thanks to your donations
