This month's meeting of the Board of Trustees will be held on **Monday, March 27, 2017 at 8:00 p.m.** We welcome you to come and join us at that time. Your input and involvement is always welcome.

The annual Village tax bill was mailed at the end of February. If you pay your taxes directly and have not received your tax bill, please contact the Village Office. To avoid interest penalties your **Village taxes must be paid no later than April 1, 2017.** Additionally, we ask that you please remind your gardener that permits must be renewed at Village Hall for the 2017 season. Only those gardeners holding valid permits will be permitted to work in the Village.

Just to remind you, Village elections will be held on Tuesday, June 20, 2017 at the Keystone Yacht Club. To be eligible to vote in the Village election you must be registered with the Nassau County Board of Elections. Applications to register by mail are available at Village Hall and must be in the hands of the Board of Elections no later than June 9, 2017. If you expect to be away at the time of the election, you may obtain an application for an absentee ballot at Village Hall

New York American Water will start their annual system maintenance program and hydrants will be flushed 4/19/17 to 4/28/17. You may experience discolored water during this time period. Check for discolored water before using the washing machine or dishwasher.
