- Prepare layouts in conformance to building codes
- Measure, cut, shape, assemble, and join materials made of wood, wood substitutes, lightweight steel, and other materials
- Build foundations
- Install floor beams
- Lay subflooring and erect walls and roof systems
- Fit and install windows, doors, stairs, mouldings, and hardware
- Maintain, repair, and renovate buildings and wooden structures in various jobsites within the ICI sector
- Perform both carpentry and labour tasks (i.e. lifting, shovelling, raking, etc.)
- Drive, operate and use company vehicles, equipment and tools safely, for the task it was designed
- Keep company equipment in good condition and safeguard from theft, vandalism, and damage
- Ensure proper paperwork when picking up materials/rental equipment for a project and paperwork is provided to the foreman prior to day's end for weekly submission
- Exercise good planning and preparation for the following workday (ie. fueling, collection of tools and materials, etc.)
- Provide adequate hand tools to efficiently complete carpentry works which includes concrete, woodworking, drywall boarding, taping, sanding, painting, doors and door hardware with minor

supervision at times as well as some labour (i.e. digging).

- Arrive physically and mentally prepared to work including adequate personal protective equipment (hard hat, vest, boots); appropriate work apparel (full-length pants and capped shirt); being free from the effects of drugs, alcohol, and fatigue.
- Schedule and coordinate work on site
- Instruct apprentices
- Supervise other workers (when needed)
- Work safely at all times, always keeping in mind the safety of yourself and others.
- Present appropriate image to represent the company favourably to the public, peers and to clients.
