Mayor Tobolski called the Public Meeting to order at 7:22 p.m. for August 17, 2015.

Village Attorney Gary Perlman states that this Public Hearing is being held in accordance with Section 147(f) of the Internal revenue Code of 1986, as amended on the proposed issuance by the Village of McCook of its not to exceed \$2,565,000.00 Educational Facilities Refunding Revenue Bond (Holy Family Ministries Center Project), Series 2015.

The Holy Family Ministries Center is a nonprofit organization and the bonds will be used to complete an educational facility.

The bond will not constitute a debt to the Village of McCook and will be repaid by the borrower which is Holy Family Ministries. The Holy Family Ministries gets a low interest rate and the Village receives a \$7,500.00 fee for issuing the bond.

If there are no questions or concerns the Mayor will close the Public Meeting.

Meeting adjourned at 7:24 p.m.

Mayor Tobolski asked if there was any discussion. There being none, the following Trustees voted in favor of said motion:

Clerk Sobus states that there are no new items for this evening.
