## **Program Description**

Odyssey of the Mind is an extracurricular program that encourages creative thinking, builds teamwork and promotes lifelong learning. During the Odyssey of the Mind season, students will meet to solve a long-term problem, which includes both technical and artistic elements, and practice solving spontaneous problems. Regional competitions are typically scheduled in early spring. Teams that place at the regional competition may continue on to State and possibly, World tournaments. These competitions occur between March and early June. Due to the nature of the long-term problem, students will frequently meet at places other than the school to work on problem solutions as well as travel to competitions. Odyssey of the Mind coaches and coordinators are volunteers and may or may not be employees of the school district. Although teams from schools within the District School Board of Pasco County are often honored and recognized for competitive achievements by the District School Board, the program is not a requirement of instructional programming offered by the School District, nor is it an activity over which the School Board assumes responsibility over the participants.
