


Mark your calendars for our annual "Play-a-thon" on May 4th! More info will be sent via our google group this next week.

CM MOCK EVALUTIONS

On Sunday, March 17 we are offering an exciting opportunity for all students! Our Branch Mock Evaluations allow students to play their CM literature for an evaluator and receive written comments from a certified CM evaluator. This is a great way for students to practice performing their pieces and gain the experience of the evaluation process. Our Branch President, Sarah Sandvig, has agreed to evaluate for us this year.

These mock evaluations are open to all MTAC Long Beach students, even those who are not enrolled in this year's CM program.

There is a fee of \$5 per piece. Students may play as many as four pieces. There is no memory requirement. Students will <u>not</u> play their CM technique or sightreading.
