Hornepayne Public Arena Unacceptable Behaviour Procedure

(includes C & D Paul Curling Club and Weight Room) (passed on December 19th, 2012 Resolution No. 11252)

The following is the protocol for dealing with violations against the Arena Policy during hockey season, curling events or weight training. Verbal warnings are to be given by either Arena Staff or the Arena Lead Hand only. All violations must be documented on standard 3-copy memo paper and reviewed by the Arena Lead Hand and Municipal Clerk before letters are sent. Parents are to be advised of any warnings given to minors.

First offence:

A verbal warning is given to the violator, and a letter sent to parents.

Second offence:

The violator is told to leave the premises for 1 week, and a registered letter is sent (to the parents if the violator is a minor) detailing the offence and explaining why a 1 week suspension was given.

Third offence:

The violator is told to leave the premises for 2 weeks, and a registered letter is sent (to the parents if the violator is a minor) detailing the offence and explaining why a 2 week suspension was given.

Fourth offence:

The violator is told to leave the premises for the remaining hockey (or curling) season, and a registered letter is sent (to the parents if the violator is a minor) detailing the offence and explaining why the suspension was given.

If anyone under suspension enters the Arena/Curling Club facility, they will be considered as Trespassers and the police shall be called.
