Health Requirements

- (A) Llamas moved within Ohio for exhibition when presented for exhibition must show no evidence of contagious or infectious disease.
- (B) Llamas imported into Ohio for exhibition must be accompanied by a certificate of veterinary inspection issued within thirty (30) days and must not show any signs of contagious or infectious disease at exhibition.

Registration Requirements:

All llamas five months or older entered in approved classes, with the exception of Youth Classes and Non-Breeder, must be registered with the International Lama Registry(ILR). Copies of registration papers are not required but entry must clearly show registration number of all entries and owners' ILR Owner Code.

Youth Ages: Junior 7-11; Intermediate 12-15, Senior 16-19 as of January 1st. Those that have their seventh birthday during the year are eligible to show as of that day.

<u>Awards</u>: Ribbons & premiums to 4 places, Youth to 5 places (amount according to entries). Grand & Reserve Champions Best-of- Show Male – All Male and Non-Breeder Grand Champions eligible

Best-of-Show Female – All Female Grand Champion eligible

Non-Breeder – Class to be split depending upon entries received

<u>Produce of Dam/Get of Sire Classes</u> – You may count this class as your 'second' entry for your llamas. Please be sure to fill out a separate box for this entry, listing the information about the Sire or Dam and also which animals will actually be shown (Produce of Dam Class – 2 animals, Get of Sire Class – 3 animals). Remember to include the appropriate animal fee (ILR-SD fee of \$3) for your Dam and/or Sire on the entry form.

Youth Exhibitors: Youth cannot enter the same animal in both the youth performance classes and open performance classes. They must take a different animal through the open classes. Youth may not share animals.
