Our pool has been very busy this year!! Which is a good thing. It's a great place to meet neighbors and share the refreshing space. With higher than normal use, we have to pay close attention to the balance of chemicals and usage by residents to keep our pool healthy and clean.

It is written on the **Rules of the Pool "Resident should accompany their guest(s) to the pool."** Although this does not always take place you the resident are still responsible for your guest(s) activity at the pool.

The last board meeting it was discussed:

- 1. A resident who is away for an extended length of time, should not give permission or entry gate key to persons checking on their house (Guests, Relatives, Cleaners, Property Agents). The resident would not be available to monitor or address the use of the pool by so called Guest(s). The responsibility should not be left to another Resident to have to monitor another resident guest.
- 2. If you own the home but have renters (renters are the resident). Only the persons renting the home would have access to the pool. Not owners living off property.

We appreciate your help in keeping our pool space clean and healthy for all 150 Residents of Casa del Cielo.



Want Shade and Fantastic Fall Color?

Consider a Red Push Ornamental Pistache tree. If you're looking to replace a tree in your yard, the Red Push Ornamental Pistache tree has been added to the CdC approved trees. This deciduous, drought tolerant tree grows to about 25'- 40' with a spread of 20'-30'. Summer color is lush green and changes to fall colors in the cooler months.

Reminder: Safety Tips on behalf of Scottsdale Police Department

At the Scottsdale Ranch Annual Meeting in April, Officer Anthony Miller provided a few tips to keep our community safe. Although, he was happy to report SR is very safe, the following tips are nice reminders:

- Theft of catalytic converters is on the rise, mostly targeting vehicles left on the street. Be mindful where you park your vehicle.
 - Items have been taken from garages with doors left open for extended periods. Be careful to keep your garage door closed.



- It's recommended you do not leave your key fob in your car, even if your car is in the garage with the garage door shut. In case of a break-in, thieves would also have access to your vehicle.
- With an increase of package deliveries, be sure to get any packages delivered to your front door as soon as possible to avoid theft.

One of the best deterrents to keeping our community safe is knowing your neighbors and being on the lookout for suspicious activity. If you see something suspicious, by all means report it to the Scottsdale Police Department and to the CdC HOA. We all need to work together to keep our area safe.
