A DELIGHTFUL TALE OF NOW AND THEN COMES YOUR WAY THIS MAY

The Barnstable Comedy Club concludes its 95th Season with the dramedy, *Come Back to the 5 & Dime, Jimmy Dean, Jimmy Dean* written by Ed Graczyk and directed by Carol McManus.

In a small town dime store in West Texas, the 'Disciples of James Dean' gather for their twentieth reunion. Now middle-aged women, they were teenagers when Dean filmed 'Giant' two decades later in nearby Marfa. One of them, an extra in the film, has a child whom she says was conceived with Dean during the shoot. The ladies' congenial reminiscences mingle with flash backs to their youth; then the arrival of a stunning but familiar stranger sets off a series of confrontations that smash their delusions and expose bitter disappointments.
