This publication denotes items that are considered to be a Fall planting hazard by Johnson Farms, Inc. There are a multitude of scenarios that create a hazard and each Genus responds differently to being dug and planted in the Fall season.

The following items are considered to be a Fall Hazard and as such no claims will be accepted on these items:
