July's Club Meeting

The club met on July 6, 2017 at 1773 Warm Spring Rd. Chambersburg, PA, 17202. The social began at 6:30pm, and the meeting started at 7:00pm.

The president opened the meeting with a few announcements that have been incorporated throughout the newsletter.

The monthly raffle was held and several prizes were won. The club also auctioned four pieces of wood. A big "Thank You" goes out to all of our high bidders. Thanks to their donations, the club was able to add \$84.00 to the club funds.

Bob Robinson handed out copies of the club's By-Laws to members present at the club meeting, so they would have the opportunity to review the proposed changes. Basically, any reference to board of directors was removed, and changes were made to the officer's meetings section. The club will vote in August whether or not to incorporate the changes.

Bob Robinson is the chair for the "Breast Cancer Project", and provided the club instructions for making the ice cream scoop handles. It is important that the handles are made per instructions, because the engraver needs room to place an inscription. Bob needs 52 handles made, and he would like to have them completed by the August club meeting so he can send them to the engraver.

Evon Barvinchack was the demonstrator for the night. If you have a challenge of drilling a hole and it starts out on center and ends up off center, Evon may have a solution for you. The trick is to use your lathe as a boring machine. Evon demonstrated the process and has good luck drilling a hole this way. He also went over CA glue as a finish, and shared some knowledge on the different types and applications of CA glue. He also showed how to apply the CA glue as a finish and provided a few safety tips.

Lee Burkholder recorded the demo, and it should be posted on his channel shortly. Lee also mentioned that due to copyright laws with the music on the clips, he is required to remove all the clips and re-do them.
