# Professing Godliness

**1 Timothy 2:9-10** "In like manner also, that women adorn themselves in modest apparel, with shamefacedness and sobriety; not with broided hair, or gold, or pearls, or costly array; 10 But (which becometh women professing godliness) with good works." (KJV)

**Modest Apparel Definition:** Clothing that is sensible, discrete, humble, and simple.

1. It is when a woman consciously decides to dress in a way that neither reveals most of her body nor accentuates it.
2. Modest clothing includes wearing clothing that is not too tight to reveal body characteristics and one that is not see-through.

**Situation:** In these verses Paul is emphasizing women's preparation – Spiritual vs Physical. Paul is encouraging the women that are professing Godliness to consider what is appropriate for the occasion.



If you go to the gym you wear gym clothes, If you go to the beach you wear beach clothes, each occasion requires us to consider what is appropriate to wear. So when you come in the presence of God to worship and praise him, you should be clothed in modest apparel.

During the time this was written, women would braid their hair in very elaborate styles with costly jewelry, which did not show their humility; rather it showed their importance, their social class their physical beauty.

As women of God today, we have to consider our purpose as professed women of God, not just in church, but every where we go. The Bible says you are the light of the world.
