

Desoto Central High School Baseball Booster Club, Inc. Bylaws

Effective May 2006

Revised 7/2015 by Baseball Booster Board Members

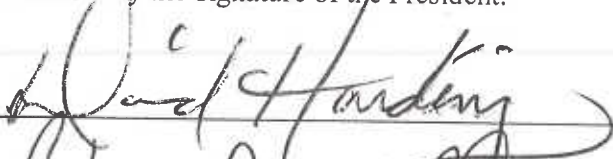
1. The following officers will be elected once a year for one year duration each year in May:
 - a. President
 - b. Vice President
 - c. Treasurer
 - d. Secretary
 - e. One representative for each grade (total of 4 – 9th, 10th, 11th, 12th – The representative for the 9th grade team will not be elected until after the members of the 9th grade team have been selected.
2. All individuals whose names are placed in nomination for one of the officer positions named in item 1 above must be members in good standing as defined in item 10 below.
3. All individuals whose names are placed in nomination must have been nominated by another member in good standing. No self-nominations will be allowed.
4. The elected officers will also compose the Board of Directors for the Desoto Central High School Baseball Boosters, Inc. (the Corporation). No more than one family member of a player on the Desoto High School Baseball Team will serve on the Board in a term.
5. Changes in Bylaws must be ratified by the Board of Directors.
6. The fiscal year for the corporation will run from August to end of July.
7. The membership year shall be defined as August to May.
8. Every player's family will be given the opportunity to join the Booster Club. For every paid membership, the family will be given one vote. In the event that a player's parents are divorced, each parent will be given the opportunity to join.
9. Booster Club dues of \$100 will be due no later than the October Board meeting.
10. Officers will be elected by members in good standing of the Desoto High School Booster Club. Said elections will be held in May of each year.
 - a. Good standing will be defined as having paid the current year's membership dues on time, at least one parent must work a fundraiser or other event, including concessions, must attend at least 50% of the booster club meetings.
 - b. Good standing will also require that the member be related to a current member of the Desoto Central High School Baseball Team.

11. Parents of graduating Seniors will not be allowed to vote in the May election of new Board members.
12. The sole purpose of the Corporation will be to raise money for the Desoto Central High School Baseball Team.
13. All fundraising activities must be approved by the Board.
14. At no time may monies collected in the name of the Corporation be used to personally benefit a member of the Corporation or their child for any personal gain whatsoever.
15. All expenditures over \$250 must be approved by a majority of the Board before said expenditure is disbursed or the Corporation will not be responsible for said expenditure. Any deviation from this policy becomes the personal liability of the individual or individuals who entered into the agreement. Any expenditure under \$250 entered into with only one Board member's approval must be one transaction and not commit the Board to future liabilities or expenditures above the initial expenditure limit of \$250.
16. No contract may be entered into on behalf of the Corporation without the written consent of majority of the Board.
17. Board will require President's initials on ANY Booster Club check. If President is unavailable, Vice-President will initial.
18. The Treasurer will be required to submit a monthly financial statement report to the full membership either via email or Corporation meeting.
19. The financial statements will be periodically reviewed by a 3rd party CPA under the direction of the President.
20. From time to time, the Board will call meetings of the full membership of the Corporation. The Secretary will be required to keep and publish minutes to the full membership within one week of the meeting.
21. The President will be empowered to call Board meetings from time to time. Meeting minutes will be kept and published at the next meeting to the full membership by the Secretary.
22. At no time may any Board member commit the Corporation to any enterprise, contract, commitment, or activity with liability exposure in excess to the Board's current net worth plus \$250.

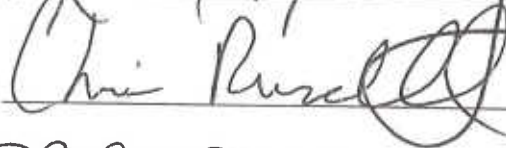
23. The Treasurer will have the responsibility for keeping and maintaining the Corporation's check book in good order.
24. The Baseball Camp fundraiser is to be held each year with the sole purpose to provide bonuses for the coaches (after expense) to be disbursed by the Head Coach.
25. The summer team may be given monies from this fund. This will require approval by the majority of the Board.
26. The original bylaws and any changes will be attested by the signature of the President.

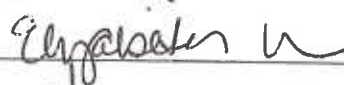
