PARKING RATES

Daily Event Rate: \$15

Flat daily rate when the RICC has events in progress. Enter our facility at or after 7:00AM and exit by midnight. Otherwise, hourly rates apply.

Overnight Rate: \$20

We are a 24/7 facility. Our Overnight Rate increments to a maximum of \$20 per each 24-hour period.

Driving Directions **from the North**

Take 95S to exit 22ABC. Merge onto 22A (Memorial Blvd.) toward Downtown. At the second light turn right onto Cookson Place. Take your next right onto West Exchange Street. Stay straight and the RI Convention Center will be directly in front of you.

Driving Directions **from the South**

Take 95N to exit 22ABC. Merge onto 22A (Memorial Blvd.) toward Downtown. Turn right onto Francis Street. At the light take a right onto West Exchange Street. The RI Convention Center will be directly in front of you.

AIRPORTS

For those flying into Providence Rhode Island, Warwick's Green International Airport (PVD) is only 10 minutes from downtown Providence and is conveniently located right off of Interstate 95. Just off Exit 13 on Interstate Route 95, Green Airport is accessible to Boston, Cape Cod and Southeastern New England. One way Uber approximately: \$15 Time by car: 13 minutes. OTHER TRANSPORTATION

The Rhode Island Public Transit Authority (RIPTA) offers low-cost bus service throughout Rhode Island. From the Roger Williams Park Zoo to dining on Federal Hill to shopping on Thayer Street and more, you can get there on RIPTA's buses and trolleys. Buses run year-round. AMTRAK

Providence is conveniently located on Amtrak's Northeast Corridor route, which runs from Boston to Washington, D.C. and back. High-speed Acela service easily transports passengers from New York City to Providence in about two hours and 30 minutes. MBTA

The Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority (MBTA) runs low-cost, round-trip rail service from Boston to downtown Providence and to Warwick's T.F. Green Airport.
