Pilot's Meeting

Call pilot's meeting at least 20 minutes before 1st launch. Shut down winches

Welcome

Introduce self New members or Guests

<u>Tasks</u>

Flight times.

Timing round off (up or down) to nearest second.

Landings

Boundaries - Mitigation fences North, East, South. Safety line West. Penalty, zero flight.

<u>Safety</u>

Gopher Holes. It's the timer's responsibility to guide the pilot. No flying at less than 100 feet altitude west of the safety line. All high speed and aerobatic flights are confined to outside of boundaries.

Windy conditions require launch assistance.

Avoid landing out in Owl Habitat

Launching

Verify plane and transmitter are on and linked.

Make sure there are no planes in the launch area.

Make sure other winch lines are down.

Announce that you are launching.

Pop offs

Master & Expert - One per day.

Sportsman – No Limit.

Participation

No paid staff. Everyone is expected to help. Match up single pilots.

Landings

Don't walk in front of another pilot who's on final.

Planes on final have right of way.

Zero landing for inverted, shed parts, or if your plane strikes you.

Zero flight if plane strikes anyone else.
