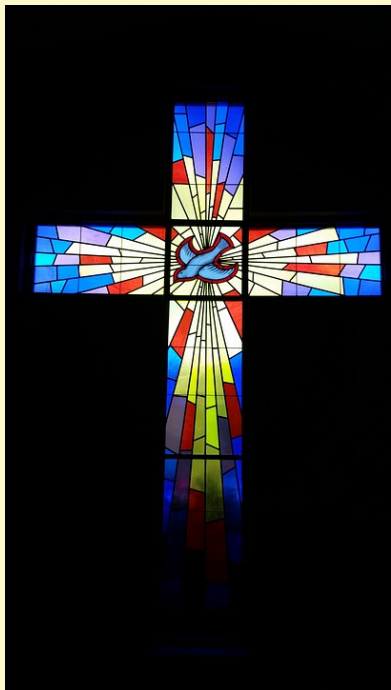

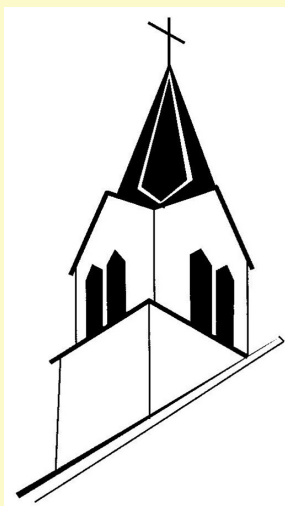

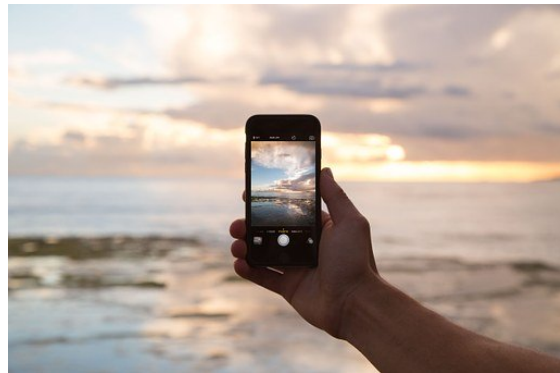
### Sunday School Closet Cleaning

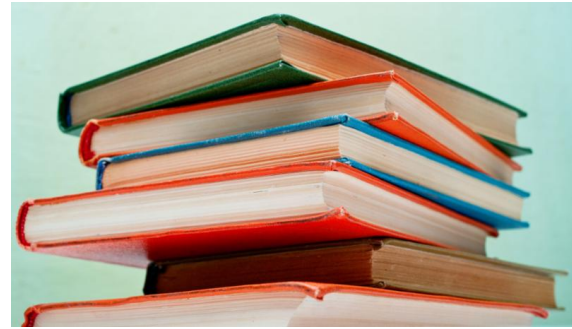
