The Speaker Jaquelyn L. Fried, RDH, BA, MS

Ms. Jacquelyn L. Fried is an Associate Professor and Director of Inter-professional Initiatives at the University of Maryland, School of Dentistry. She received her Bachelor of Arts degree in political science and her Certificate in Dental Hygiene from the Ohio State University. She earned a Master of Science in Dental Hygiene from Old Dominion University. Prior to assuming her current position, she served as Director of the Division of Dental Hygiene for ten years. Ms. Fried is well-known for her scholarly efforts related to the dental hygienist's role in tobacco cessation and prevention. Her other interest areas include inter-professional education and collaboration, scientific writing and communication, and HPV and head and neck cancers.

Ms. Fried served as a consultant to the National Cancer Institute regarding the oral health professional's role in tobacco prevention and cessation and has been active in the American Dental Hygienists' Association and the American Dental Education Association regarding tobacco issues. For ADHA, she currently serves on the Tobacco Intervention Initiative Task Force. For ADEA, she was Chair of the Tobacco-free Special Interest Group. Nationally, Ms. Fried also has served on ADHA's Councils of Education and Research, was a two term Director for the Institute of Oral Health's Grants Review Committee, and was a member of the ADHA's Task Force on the Advanced Dental Hygiene Practitioner. In 2011, she received the Old Dominion University's Gene W. Hirschfeld's School of Dental Hygiene's Alumna of the Year Award and at UMB has been selected Teacher of the Year multiple times. In 1997, she was awarded the ADHA Warner Lambert Award for Excellence in Dental Hygiene. Ms. Fried is widely published and is a national and international speaker.

The Changing Landscape of Tobacco Products: "Vaping", Smoking, and Chewing Two eras of nicotine acquisition are converging and experts are wondering if the e-cigarette will soon make combustible tobacco obsolete. As the use of e-cigarettes rises, more questions are being raised about its popularity, use, safety, impact on the tobacco use culture and on the future of the tobacco industry. This course will examine new and traditional consumer products for nicotine acquisition and tobacco use. The advantages and disadvantages of e-cigarettes and their role as a harm reduction measure for those addicted to nicotine and to the behavioral and psychosocial aspects of tobacco use will be addressed. Although long term studies on the use of e-cigarettes are unavailable, their potential side effects will be discussed. The popularity of recreational marijuana and hookah use will be explored as will the ramifications of "pot" legalization. Evidence regarding the oral and systemic impacts of tobacco use, secondhand smoke, and the effects that nicotine and combustion have on oral tissues will be presented. As new tobacco/nicotine products continue to flood the marketplace, attendees will be asked to examine their approaches to addressing "nicotine containing products", their responses to patient queries about e-cigarettes and the information they can offer their patients regarding the periodontal effects of non-traditional and more conventional products. Techniques for suggesting alternative products, and for cessation and prevention of tobacco use that incorporate motivational interviewing and federal guidelines for tobacco dependence will be reviewed.

The Human Papilloma Virus: Is Head and Neck Cancer a Sexually Transmitted Disease? This course will present cutting edge research on HPV and its association with head and neck squamous cell carcinomas (HNSCCs), illustrating how this relationship will enrich and embolden the practice of dental hygiene. Attendees will expand their knowledge base related to HPV and HNSCC's, explore the contrasts between "traditional" carcinogen induced oral cancers and HPV positive oropharyngeal cancers, and learn why some of their approaches to patient treatment may require reexamination, modification and expansion. Highlighted will be current research that suggests an association between chronic periodontal disease and some HPV-induced HNCs. The importance of biofilm removal and control of oral bacteria as a means to prevent HPV associated head and neck cancers has been suggested in recent studies, further validating the dental hygienist's relevance to addressing this disease. Dental hygienists' advocacy roles in raising awareness of HPV related head and neck cancer will be discussed. Practical examples of how to address sensitive issues with patients and to introduce related prevention information will be included. Current techniques for detecting HPV head and neck cancers will be explored as well as effective treatments. Case studies will stimulate group discussion to generate realistic and timely approaches for the prevention of HPV associated head and neck cancer.

The SPEAKER: Braden Seamons, DDS

Dr. Seamons graduated from University of the Pacific School of Dentistry and obtained his Specialty training at Naval Dental School Bethesda. He is a Board Certified Diplomate of the American Board of Periodontology. After serving 25 years in the Naval Dental Corps, he retired from active duty in 2003 and went into private practice with offices in Honolulu and Kailua. He is committed to offering innovative approaches to treatment and was the first Periodontist in Hawaii to offer Laser Therapy.

"Innovations in Periodontics & Implant Therapy"

Laser Therapy, utilizing the LANAP Protocol, offers patients a viable alternative to conventional "cut & sew" surgery. This EVIDENCE - BASED approach will be discussed at length. Additionally, the LAIP Protocol for the treatment of Peri-Implantitis will be presented. The advantages of several unique implant systems - including Ankylos, AnyRidge, and Z Systems Zirconia fixtures - will be outlined. How to enhance the effectiveness of maintenance therapy and home care instruction will round out the lecture. Audience interaction is encouraged.
