Treasurer Report

Scott J. submitted the monthly financial report. As of June 30, 2021 we had \$33,097.47 in total funds. There is \$18,030.30 in the checking account. Outstanding checks total \$3,450. The money market account has a balance of \$9,497.54 and the 12-month CD has a value of \$5,569.63. In comparing our budget to actual expenses to date, we have a positive balance of \$6,379.

We received \$470 in membership renewals this month. A total of \$19,662 has been received to date this year.
