Our Summer at FUMC has been a busy one. Vacation Bible School averaged nearly 60 children each evening who learned about the early Christian church according to the book of Acts. Over 100 children, youth, and adults participated together. Our children have also participated in programs each Monday during the summer, such as a creek stomp, bowling, and a trip to Lazy 5

Ranch.

This past Sunday our youth group returned from a three day hike in Pisgah National Forest which included part of the Appalachian Trail. A month ago 12 of our youth (and 4 adults) participated in a Carolina Cross Connection week long mission trip where they assisted in helping the elderly and those in need. This week our youth visited our church members at the nursing homes in Cherryville and Lincolnton, and last month the youth spent a day helping at "Christian Ministries" in Lincolnton and also picked vegetables at the community garden in Cherryville (and delivered the produce to those in need). The youth group has another retreat August 18 - 20.

We have been fortunate to receive another Duke Summer Intern, Kayla Keller. Kayla has taught Sunday School classes, assisted in Worship, and helped with visitation to the hospital, nursing homes, and elderly members. She has been teaching a class each Sunday evening in July, and has accompanied our children and youth on some of their outings (such as picking vegetables at the community garden).

We have come together for a combined Worship service each Sunday during the summer. We have been blessed by the music from both the chancel choir and the praise band. This summer our sanctuary has been the location of three funeral services, and the fellowship hall has been used for families to receive friends following these services.

Summer has been busy at FUMC and also for the pastor's family. My son Garrett graduated from Duke Divinity School in May, got married on Memorial weekend then began work as the Pastor at two United Methodist churches in the WNC Conference. On top of this my daughter, Elizabeth, has a "due date" in mid August which will be our first grandchild.

It has been a summer to remember in many ways. Next month 70 children will begin in our Preschool program and we will start back our 8:45am 11:00am worship services following Labor Day.

There will be a farewell covered dish luncheon to recognize and say thank you to Kayla for her service as our Summer Associate Minister on **Sunday**, **August 13**. The luncheon will begin at 11:45 a.m. in the Fellowship Hall and the church will be providing the meat. Please bring your favorite covered dish and/or dessert and stay for this time of fellowship.



Wow! This past July has been a very busy one. We started off with vacation Bible school. The children traveled to Rome, visited Paul in his house as he was

guarded by a Roman soldier, and visited the underground church. They learned about God's love and how his love is always with us, how his love saves us, how his love is worth sharing, and how his love is a gift. The children were able to raise over \$800 in offering to help buy Bibles for the Sudanese refugees. Pastor Joe, Paul, and Ms. Jeanna, all three got a cherry pie in the face. We had 111 participants for Bible school this year with over 60 children coming to hear about God's love.

Thank you to all those youth and adults that helped to make this Vacation Bible School a success.

instrumental in helping at Bible school this year. Many of them had rolls like playing a Roman soldier, the senator, shopkeeper, games keeper, and even a thief and a slave. Our youth love to be involved.

We have gone to the community garden called "God's Planned Harvest" to pick vegetables. We picked 30 boxes full of vegetables and delivered them to the community. We prayed with people and invited them to church.

Thirteen youth and adults hiked on the Appalachian Trail to raise money to help the Sudanese refugees. With the money we raise we will be buying Bibles for the refugees of Sudan written in their own language and solar-powered MP4 players loaded with the New Testament in 4 Sudanese languages. With each player, 75-100 people can hear the life giving Word of God.



The youth visited our shut-ins in the nursing homes and several of our elderly members. We enjoyed talking with them, singing with them, and praying with them. We appreciate our elderly members and do not want them to think that they have been forgotten.
