

BUILDING INSPECTOR II

The City of DeKalb, Illinois is seeking a Building Inspector II to join our team. The Building Inspector II performs technical and administrative inspection work ensuring compliance with applicable presently adopted codes and other appropriate City codes and ordinances to ensure the health, safety and welfare of the general public. Work involves on-site inspections during construction activities, responding to complaints, documenting of all inspection work and responding to emergency personnel for consultation as requested. The Building Inspector II will also perform code and plan review, investigations, issuance of building permits and certificates of occupancy and collection of applicable fees. The position requires self-discipline, collaboration and the ability to resolve violations with spontaneous problem resolution and excellent oral and written skills.

The position of Building Inspector II is assigned to the Building Division of the Community Development Department and works under the direct supervision of the Chief Building Official. The position is a full-time, position represented under AFSCME and requires the Building Inspector to work a 37.5 work-week. This position may include evenings, weekends and emergency call outs as necessary. The position will require work both indoors and outdoors and the ability to navigate all types of terrain, including that typical of a major construction site. The position further requires the ability to climb stairs and ladders, to enter and exit excavation sites, to enter and exit sites where fire or hazardous materials exist and to be involved in activities associated with severe weather occurrences. The Building Inspector II works in conjunction with the Fire Prevention Officer, Code Compliance Coordinator and Code Compliance Inspectors.

The starting hourly rate is \$29.37 per hour. The City of DeKalb provides a comprehensive benefits package that includes medical, dental, vision and prescription benefits, life insurance coverage, HSA & flexible spending accounts, deferred compensation and participation in the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund (IMRF).

The Building Inspector II position is classified as an emergency response position and does have a residency requirement that is listed in the on-line posting.
