Former Elkton Mayor Dies 1965

Word has been received here of the death of George V. Hartman, 71, former Elkton mayor and Huron county newspaper publisher.

Hartman was publisher of the Elkton Advance from 1937 to 1947. He was also employed at the Huron Daily Tribune and the Sebewaing Blade at times after that date

Hartman died at Slidell, Louisiana, on Sunday. He and his wife had been spending the winter months in Bradenton, Florida and were going to visit. Mrs. Hartman's daughter in Texas at the time Mr. Hartman suffered a heart attack.

Born December 4 in Canada he came to the United States in 1901. Upon his release from service in World War I. 'Hartman came to Elkton in 1919.

He married Florence Smith of Pigeon in 1922. She died in 1959 after an auto accident. He married Mrs. Marion Stevens, of Flint, in 1960.

Surviving him are his widow, one stepdaughter, one sister, Mrs. Beth Howey, Flint, and three brothers, Theodore and Fred, Flint, and Earl of Davison, and three grandchildren.
