JOIN NOW for 2018

We are sending out our typical January newsletter a month early so those of you who would like to get a jump-start on using the 2018 discount card can sign up now for delivery at the start of January. Each household that pays the \$25 annual dues will be given 2 reusable discount cards. Many have found that the savings from the card more than pays for their dues. Why not give it a shot and join?

Remember, joining our voluntary neighborhood HOA does not impact the freedoms you enjoy as a Valle Vista resident. The HOA has no control over what you do on your property. The primary restrictions are the ones put in place by the local and state governments.

Ways to pay to join V V HOA:

- Mail a check to the HOA (see address above)
- Drop off cash or check
- Go online to our website to join and pay via PayPal

Discount cards and any other coupons/deals will be mailed to each household unless you want to pick them up or have them delivered to your home. Please indicate on your form or the website your preferred delivery method.

WHAT INCENTIVES ARE THERE FOR JOINING?

- Local community reusable discount card good for one calendar year (January to December)
- FREE attendance to gain personal enrichment in various HOA hosted seminars & activities
- Ability to place in the annual Green Thumb community curb appeal competition

In addition, the board funds the advertising for the spring and fall garage sales, prepares and sends out at least three newsletters each year, holds an annual meeting for all neighborhood residents with guest speakers to educate on area happenings and safety, provides welcome baskets to new residents, maintains a website, and coordinates neighborhood activities like the plant swap. These activities benefit the neighborhood as a whole, and we hope the board's effort to keep them going year after year encourages households to join.
