The parade is at night, so all entries need to be lighted!

<u>WALKERS</u> – Anyone walking will need to meet at the corner of 3rd and Walnut (*First Christian Church*) <u>DO NOT line up at the Fire Department or you will not be able to join the parade.</u>

FLOATS - Entries will be judged by randomly pre-selected volunteers. Floats will be judged on creativity, originality, and depiction of theme. All floats, cars/trucks, horseback, etc. need to be lined up at the North Lake Park (*in front of the Recreation Center*) at the times stated above. Remember, your float should <u>not</u> include Santa Claus, he will be arriving on the fire truck at the end of the parade. All Floats will line up at the North Lake.

FLOATS - Entries will be judged on creativity, originality, and depiction of theme.
