

COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS

January 25, 2016

The Jewell County Commissioners met January 25, 2016 at 8:30 a.m. with Commissioners, Mark Fleming, Steve Greene and Dwight S. Frost present. Carla J. Waugh, County Clerk was also present.

The minutes of the January 19, 2016 County Commissioners meeting were approved as printed.

The Commissioners conducted office head meeting. The following were present for the meeting: Chris Petet, Custodian; Chuck Latham, County Appraiser; Shannon Meier, Ambulance Director; Brenda Eakins, Treasurer Angela Murray, Health Nurse; Joel Elkins, General Superintendent; Kim Ost, Undersheriff and Travis Garst, Solid Waste Director. (The following were absent: Anna Standley, Register of Deeds; Jenae Ryan, District Extension Agent; and Gail Bartley, Noxious Weed Director, Emergency Preparedness Director and 911 Coordinator.)

Travis Garst said they have the chipper running. He has the trailer at Bourbon's to get estimate for repairs.

Joel Elkins said they have been working on roads. They also have been replacing 9-1-1 road signs.

Chuck Latham said he has been working on final review and is about done with the residential review. He still has the commercial property review to complete.

Chris Petet reported the elevator is leaking hydraulic fluid. Chris said there are more leaks in the roof.
