#### **Dear Hope Family:**

I was reading a memoir by the Christian writer, Phillip Yancey, Where The Light Fell, about his growing up with an unforgiving mother. She would say, upon Phillip's saying sorry for doing something wrong, "Well, if you really are sorry, you wouldn't have done it in the first place." Ouch.

We are approaching Ash Wednesday and Lent. All of this – the book and the approaching change in the church season towards Lent and then Holy Week - that got me thinking. How do we forgive? Why do we forgive?

I was drawn to another writer, Brennan Manning, and his daily devotional readings found in *Reflections for Ragamuffins*. I'll quote in full the reading for February 17<sup>th</sup>.

#### Tender Judgement

The ultimate reason why we may forgive instead of condemning is because God himself does not condemn but forgives. Because he has freely chosen to put tenderness before law, we are authorized to do the same.

In the imagery of the parables, God is constantly presented as the father rushing out to meet his son, the absurdly generous farmer who gives the latecomers the same wage as the day-long laborer, the judge hearing the prayer of the importunate [that means persistent, especially to the point of annoyance] widow.

In the man Jesus the invisible God becomes visible and audible... Jesus Christ taught prophetically, in the power of the Spirit, that Christian giving and forgiving should copy God's giving and forgiving.

Acceptance is absolute, without inquiry into the past, without special conditions, so that the liberated sinner can live again, accept himself, forgive himself, love himself.

...because of the tender mercy of our God by which the rising sun will come to us from heaven to shine on those living in darkness and in the shadow of death, to guide our feet into the path of peace.

Luke 1:78-79

Amen. I love Brennan's words on the tender mercy of our God. We are forgiven. With the help of God, let us be a forgiving people.








Pastor Peter Lurvey Welcomes All to Hope Lutheran Church
