One was wearing a face veil, so I told her it is not written in the Koran; it is only tradition, so you don't have to wear it. She replied she doesn't want people to look at her so she wants to wear it. I gave her an Arabic tract with a story of the history of the Muslims in the Negev & how they turned from Christianity when the Islamic armies came through.

The other woman asked if I had another tract, so I gave her one also. The Russian woman in front of me turned and gave them a greeting in Arabic. Seeds of the Gospel being sown among pleasant conversation.

Eddie was told by a young man that it was dangerous wearing the Yeshua loves you T-shirt and that he was afraid for him, but also admired him for it.

The Ultra-Orthodox Jews are stirring up trouble again in Arad, harassing the believers and picketing the Russian Congregation.
