Paul Miller, Field Operations Supervisor, was honored by the Board of Directors at their July 15th Board Meeting as they passed a resolution highlighting his accomplishments with the District. Paul will be retiring from the District at the end of July.

Board Meeting Highlights

Regular Board Meetings are the Third Thursday at 6:30 PM

April - Due to the COVID-19 pandemic and subsequent Governor's Orders, the April Board Meeting was held using remote meeting technology. Supervisor Miller was excused and General Manager Huff reported on the maintenance issues for the month, preparations for the Deer Lick pipeline project, the arrival of the new hoist for the sewer lift station, and operational discussion regarding Master Plan needs. Chief Ozias reported on the Fire Department calls, preparations for the ISO inspection, and current recruiting success. In his administrative report General Manager Huff reported on the successful new hire at the Utility Worker position and his continued work on the Emergency Response Plan. The Board approved joining CalWARN and the State's Mutual Aid Agreement as part of readiness preparation in case of a disaster or emergency.

May - Due to the COVID-19 pandemic and subsequent Governor's Orders, the May Board Meeting was held using remote meeting technology. Supervisor Miller was excused and General Manager Huff reported on the maintenance issues for the month and the delays to the Deer Lick pipeline project due to material shortages and previously unknown live waterlines in the area.

Chief Ozias reported on the Fire Department calls, his attendance at a volunteer recruitment seminar, and efforts to provide additional weatherization for the fire station. In his administrative report General Manager Huff reported on the audit progress, attendance at a rate study seminar, and progress on the 21-22 budget. The Board discussed additional security measures that could be taken to protect District facilities and approved simplification of the coverage compensation for volunteer firefighters.



June - Due to the COVID-19 pandemic and subsequent Governor's Orders, the June Board Meeting was held using remote meeting technology. Supervisor Miller was excused and General Manager Huff reported on the maintenance issues for the month and the progress being made on the Deer Lick pipeline and Sewer Lift Station Valves projects. Chief Ozias reported on the Fire Department calls for May and that the annual Arrowbear Lake Fire Fighter's Association Picnic will be held August 21, 2021 at Tucker Field in Arrowbear. General Manager Huff provided a presentation for the Board regarding the current drought conditions in California and the District's preparedness for those conditions. The Board discussed and approved the upcoming FY 21-22 budget as well as associated annual motions and resolutions.
