### **Deposit and Fees**

Your deposit reserves your spot in your requested week of camp. If you need to cancel and do so within 14 days of the first day of camp, you will receive a full refund of your deposit. If the cancellation is less than 14 days before the first day of camp, AND your spot can be filled by another camper, you will receive a full refund. If the spot is not filled, the deposits will not be refunded.

#### Camp includes

Riding 1 to 2 times per day in a group setting Riding skills Safety Grooming and Horse Health Saddling Tack care and cleaning

#### What to wear

Clothes appropriate for the weather and that can get dirty

Riding pants, long pants or jeans to wear while riding

Boots or shoe with a hard sole and small heel. Paddock boots are best, and can often be found on consignment.

Helmets are provided, but if you have a riding helmet please bring it. Sunscreen - please apply sunscreen before coming to camp.

#### What to bring

Water, and other drink for lunch or snack.

Lunch, snacks and drinks each day. Lunches should be packed in a cooler or a lunch bag with an ice pack. We reserve space in our coolers for ice and additional drinks.

Sunscreen to reapply throughout the day.

Shorts to change into when finished riding, if you would like.

Bag or backpack to keep your things organized.

Beach towel for last day of camp -- weather permitting we will play in the hose/sprinkler.

## **Drop-off and Pick-up Policy**

Please arrive by 9 a.m. We meet at the gazebo which is straight down the farm's driveway by the jump arena. Children cannot be left unsupervised at Stone Place Stables. Please pick up your camper by 3 p.m.

#### \*\*In the event your child is not picked up by 3 p.m., a \$10 late fee WILL be charged.\*\*

Camp instructors conduct private lessons after camp and therefore cannot supervise campers after 3 p.m. If someone other than the person designated on the registration form is picking up your child, please provide information to Sarah Younger in advance: name of person picking up child, relationship to child, and cell phone of person picking up child. If you need to make a special arrangement, please contact Sarah at least one day in advance.

#### Camp Rules

- -Riders are to follow the rules and regulations set forth in the Stone Place Stables Riding Release/Waiver and covered during the first day of camp.
- -Helmets and protective shoes must be worn at all times when riding and working around horses.
- -Cell phones or other electronics brought to camp are the camper's responsibility. Cell phones/electronics are to be left in the rider's bag at the gazebo and may be used during lunchtime, after camp, or with a counselor's permission.
- -Treat instructors, volunteer counselors and other campers with respect. Follow counselor's instructions. -If you are not sure (about anything), ask first.
