The season is slowly coming to an end. There are still a few things to do when the weather is permitting So get out and enjoy.



Tech Tip

Battery Post Cleaner Solves Light Problem

Having trouble with the lights on your car? If there are not sufficiently grounded the cause could be corrosion in the socket and/or base of the lamp. A good cleaning can usually solve your problem. A good way to clean is to use a battery terminal wire brush cleaner. Insert the male end of the brush into the lamp socket and give it several turns. Then stick lamp base into the female end of the battery post cleaner and twist the bulb several times.


