- Responses and solutions related to CERCLA, RCRA corrective action, and hazardous waste treatment unit investigations, closures, and reporting with regulatory agencies and third parties to minimize regulatory impact and compliance issues.
- Remediation solutions that minimize regulatory impact and compliance related to development of real property.
- Management of a broad portfolio of corporate legacy sites in various stages of investigation and remediation as well as sites with multiple parties, cost allocations, and responsible party coordination committees including replacement water supply agreement negotiation and implementation.
- Negotiations with regulatory agencies and management of compliance with applicable orders, agency directives, and permits.
- Financial assurance obligations for portfolio of sites.
- Manage projects to achieve cost and schedule commitment to Annual Plan using multidisciplinary team of internal/external professionals and contractors integrating responses with internal stakeholders including finance, legal, operations and risk management.
- Prepare and maintain accurate financial documentation, including budget projections, environmental liability reserve amounts consistent with accounting guidance, including Sarbanes Oxley, and development of project cost/benefit analyses to support business decisions.
- Work with other organization staff and management team to develop strategic direction for remediation and implementation of environmental related projects and/or litigation support.
- Integrate and monitor internal and external SH&E programs and requirements into the remediation programs including job hazard analyses.
- Present technical information to public and regulatory agencies in writing and in public forums.
