TERRACES

Break long slopes into shorter ones. They usually follow the contour. As water makes it way down a hill, terraces serve as small dams to intercept water and guide it to an outlet.

There are two basic types of terraces--storage terraces and gradient terraces. Storage terraces collect water and store it until it can infiltrate into the ground or be released through a stable outlet. Gradient terraces are designed as a



channel to slow runoff water and carry to a stable outlet like a grassed waterway.
