#### **Congregational Meeting Minutes**

Trinity United Church of Christ's Annual meeting was held on Sunday, January 28, 2018. The meeting was called to order at 11:02 by President Robin Hansen. Reverend Don Corbin opened with prayer. A copy of the annual report and updated church directory was given to those in attendance. Council plans to trial a youth member on council; they will be a voting member.

New sound system has been purchased but has not been delivered. This sound system will allows us to be more mobile for events.

Trustees are working on a priority list for projects at the church. First on the agenda is to replace the floor in the Branching Out classrooms off the kitchen. It has been decided to get laminate and not carpet as that is a heavily trafficked area. Quotes from Genoa Custom Interiors have been obtained, price is \$3,185 for labor and materials. Mike Diekman made a motion to purchase the flooring and have Genoa Custom Interiors install. Jen Laughlin 2<sup>nd</sup>. MC. The wooden exterior doors at the south entrance of the church need attention. It will cost \$2300 every two years to maintain the current doors. Council has decided to look into different options for doors i.e glass or metal.

Discussion has been held by council in regards to starting a Capital Improvement Fund. Most churches have these. May start fundraising for projects, will need ideas from congregation and/or committee. Council has determined it would like to invest a portion of the profits from the sale of the parsonage. Approx \$25,000 will be invested to accure interest. Council will meet with a financial advisor. Don Corbin will get information on a fund available for churches. John Bast made a motion to invest \$25,000 from the parsonage fund. Jim Laughlin 2<sup>nd</sup>. MC.

Ben Sutter, council VP, held an informational session regarding Legacy Gifts and church donations. If interested in setting up a legacy gift or for more information congregational members can talk to Ben.

Don Corbin would like to see a pastor relations committee formed. More discussion to be held in council.

A motion to adjourn meeting was made by Mike Diekman,  $2^{nd}$  Ben Sutter. Meeting adjourned at 11:30.
