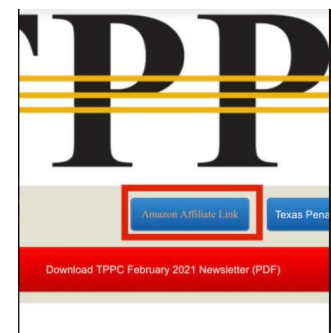

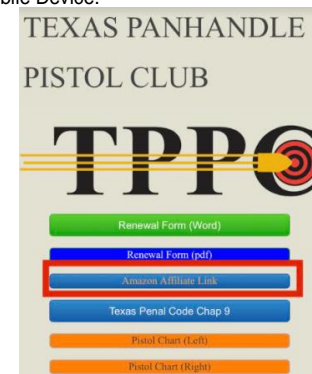

Dry Firing – [Mantis Blackbeard](#)

Blackbeard: the auto-resetting trigger system for AR-15 (following information it from their website)

This is a drop-in Bolt Carrier Group + magazine that works with your existing trigger. It has the same weight, break, and reset. Your dry fire practice just became 100x more effective and engaging.

The White House's announcement last week that President Joe Biden was withdrawing the nomination of David Chipman for Director of the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives (ATF) was a victory for the firearm industry and gun owners in general. However, it's not the end of the Biden gun control agenda. Not by a long shot. Republicans have also been vocal about Mr. Chipman's open support for assault weapons bans and his push for universal background checks, two initiatives backed by President Biden.

Chipman's nomination was evident of that. Even though his nomination isn't on the table any longer, he's still being considered for an administration role and other control efforts that violate Second Amendment rights are in motion. The withdrawal of Chipman's nomination isn't the end. There is still work to be done.

AUGUST GUN SALES DOWN BUT DEMAND

Excerpt from Guns in the News ([AUGUST GUN SALES DOWN BUT DEMAND](#))

August firearm sales, estimated by volume of NICS checks conducted by the FBI, came in at 1.4 million units according to Small Arms Analytics & Forecasting (SAAF). The figure represents a drop of 16.8 percent compared to last year, but in a press release last week SAAF Chief Economist put things in perspective by explaining, "...the current year-to-date total of nearly 13.4 million firearms sold is by far the highest level for the first two-thirds of any year except for 2020."
