<u>Subject</u> Wearing of Uniform	CP# 2-06 Initiated 3/1/2015

A. PURPOSE

1. It is the intent of the Terryville Fire Department to ensure that members represent the Terryville Fire Department in a positive and professional manner when wearing the department uniform.

B. PROCEDURE

- 1. All uniforms and issued hardware, badges, etc., are property of the Terryville Fire District and shall not be worn unless authorized. Pre-authorized events shall include inspections, funerals, parades, and memorial services. Other details or events shall require authorization from the Chief of Department or designee. Members are required to wear black shoes, black socks and black belt when wearing the Class A or Class B uniform.
- 2. The Class A uniform shall consist of the following:
 - a. Class A Jacket
 - b. Navy blue pants
 - c. White or blue Class B shirt with tie
 - d. Hat
 - e. White gloves
 - f. Authorized badges and devices
- 3. The Class B uniform shall consist of the following:
 - a. White or blue Class B Shirt
 - b. Collar brass on Class B shirt
 - c. Navy blue pants
 - d. Hat
 - e. Tie (when directed)
- 4. The white Class B shirt shall be worn by all Chiefs, Ex-Chiefs, Department Chaplain, and company officers.
- 5. The blue Class B shirt shall be worn by all other members not listed above.
- 6. Five-year pins (stars) shall be worn on the left sleeve of the Class A jacket. Stars shall be placed in a neat and orderly manner.

- 7. Authorized citation bars shall be worn centered above the breast badge.
- 8. The American Flag pin shall be worn centered above the breast badge, atop any other breast bar or device.
- 9. Mourning bands shall be worn when directed by the Chief of Department.
- 10. Issued officer / ex-officer insignia shall be worn on the collar of both the Class A jacket and Class B shirt. The maltese cross device shall be worn only on the collar of the Class B shirt.
- 11. In the event of inclement weather, the issued trench coat may be worn if authorized by the Chief.
