- Enclosures: excludes dog training enclosures from requirements clarifies that permittee must only meet the minimum requirements
- Mobile facility: requires those held in mobile facility more than 10 days to meet general caging requirements
- Inspections: replaces permit revocation with access allows inspections of property holding facilities are on inspection failure is if any deficiencies found or not allowed inspection and given 10 days to correct must allow inspections
- Permit denial and revocation: NEW section
 - Denial: revises old denial reason for violating this regulation and the exotic wildlife one by adding shooting area, import of game birds, falconry, shoot-to-retrieve field trial, furbearer seasons AND includes statutes and federal laws regarding hunting, fishing or wildlife, violating any department regulation, providing false information and failing inspection REPLACES acquisition before receiving permit with captive wildlife permit, transportation permit, or commissioner's exemption
 - Revocation: adds same text as denial adds if permit is revoked then all their facility permits are
 - Denial period: creates denial period for revoked or suspended permits
- Commissioner's exemption: may revoke if enclosures fail to prevent escape or public contact, not complying with exemption letter provisions, other reason to protect public health and safety, native ecosystems, native wildlife if revoked must remove prohibited from state in 48 hours

- Confiscation: requires seizure if permit or commissioner's exemption revoked or not acquired must be released, transferred or dispatched (RVS immediately dispatched) does not allow return to owner allows surrendering
- Administrative Hearing: also allows for denials must be in writing and postmarked or hand delivered in 30 days
