

ALL-YOU-CAN-EAT PANCAKE MEAL - HIGH SCHOOL CAFETERIA (7 AM - 2 PM) & MASONIC LODGE (9 AM - 3 PM): Adults - \$8; Children 5-12 - \$6; 4 & Under are Free.

1861 BUILDING - Now the Marathon Area Historical Society's Museum - filled with exhibits; lots of opportunities to chat with area folks!! Celebrating Marathon's 200th Birthday!

AMERICAN LEGION: Hop on a shuttle bus and enjoy the cake wheel, raffles, & crafts. Food - pancake breakfast, French fries, hot sausage, burgers, Sons of American Legion's beef barbecue, hot dogs, chili, coffee, hot chocolate.

BAPTIST CHURCH GYM: (10 AM-Noon, both days) - FREE coffee, donuts & hot chocolate. All Day Saturday: face painting, "Dan the Snake Man," bounce house, and crafts. Sunday (10 AM 'til Noon): musical performances & maple demonstrations. All Day Sunday: "Dan the Snake Man."
