To provide disaster case management in 5 Texas counties

HOUSTON, Texas - Disaster & Humanitarian Services, a Houston-based 501(c)(3) non-governmental organization (DHS-NGO) has signed a subcontract agreement with Disaster Services Corporation, SVDP-USA to provide disaster case management services to families impacted by Hurricane Harvey. DHS-NGO will provide disaster case management services to families located in Harris, Ft. Bend, Brazoria and Jefferson Counties under the agreement.

“DHS-NGO is excited to be a part of the Disaster Services Corporation team and we look forward to serving people impacted by Harvey,” said Pastor T. Leon Preston, II, DHS-NGO’s board chair. “DHS-NGO’s mission is to serve people in need of assistance following a humanitarian disaster and help them recover. DHS-NGO was founded by Houston resident Laurie A. Robinson based on her mission to serve people in need. “My passion is to serve and from the experience I gained from project managing several disaster recovery projects since 2005, I knew I was on the right path by creating Disaster & Humanitarian Services. Living on the gulf coast of Texas I knew our services would be needed,” said Robinson.
