DESCRIPTION: Great looking and performing George Birnie designed recurve. Black and tan Marblewood riser. Bow has no delamination: no cracks; limbs are straight. Beveled arrow shelf. Overlays and tips are in great condition. No drilled holes; No chips, dings or cracks. No crazing or stress cracks; A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. The only flaws with this bow are a number of filled scratches/gouges on the limbs (see pics) and the superficial stress lines in the riser fade-outs. These have been filled and tested. Every Renegade I have ever seen has had stress lines in the fade-outs, likely due to the steep bends of the riser face. I put this bow to a stress test (held at full draw for 16 hours to make sure the old laminate glues held and the stress lines did not expand). Decal is in excellent condition. Overall, this is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age.
