

AMENDMENT OF BYLAWS
OF

By unanimous written consent, as authorized in Article III, Section 5, of the Bylaws of Colony Crossing Homeowners' Association, all three Directors of the Corporation unanimously adopt the following amendment to the Corporation's Bylaws, dated July 25, 1986:




This Amendment to the Bylaws is executed in accordance with Article 1396-2.09 of the Texas Non-Profit Corporation Act, as amended.
