# General Rules

- 1. For horse show purposes, the age of an exhibitor will be considered as of December 1, 2024.
- 2. Dress is casual.
- 3. All riders cannot ride anywhere on the showgrounds without wearing protective headgear passing ASTM-SEI standards. Harnesses must be secured and if headgear has a brim it must be flexible or semi-flexible. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until their headgear is properly in place.
- 4. Cross entering between Pleasure classes and Hunter classes is permitted.
- 5. Management reserves the right to change the location of any class if necessary and to cancel or combine any classes if entries so warrant.
- 6. NO person will be allowed in the ring during judging unless on official business.
- 7. The State of Maryland requires that all horses and ponies must be in possession of a current negative Coggins Certificate taken within 12 months.
- 8. Vaccination Record/Proof of Vaccination for EHV1/4 (given with 180 days of show date) for every equine on premises.
- 9. Self Certification of Equine Health required for every equine on premises.
- 10. Champion and Reserve Champion Ribbons will be awarded in classes 1-39.
- 11. Six ribbons will be awarded in all classes.
- 12. Entry Fee will be \$15.00 per class.

- 2. Lead Line Walk Unattached To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk with leadline unattached.
- 3. Lead Line Unattached Over Poles To be shown over 4 poles.

# Mini Short Stirrup Division

Open to riders 9 years and under. To be judged 50% on child's hands and seat and 50% on mount's quietness and suitability. No martingales.

- 4. Mini Short Stirrup Walk To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk.
- 5. Mini Short Stirrup Walk-Trot To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk and trot.
- 6. Mini Short Stirrup Walk-Trot Over 4 Poles To be shown over 4 poles.

#### **Beginner Rider Division**

Open to riders in their 1st or 2nd year of showing. To be judged 50% on hands and seat and 50% on mount's quietness and suitability. No martingales.

- 7. Beginner Rider Walk To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk.
- 8. Beginner Rider Walk-Trot To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk and trot.
- 9. Beginner Rider Walk-Trot Over 4 Poles To be shown over 4 poles.

#### **Short Stirrup Equitation Division**

Open to riders 10 years and under. To be judged 50% on hands and seat and 50% on mount's quietness and suitability.

- 10. Short Stirrup Equitation Walk-Trot To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk and trot. No martingales.
- 11. Short Stirrup Equitation Under Saddle To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, trot and canter. No martingales.
- 12. Short Stirrup Equitation Over Fences To be shown over 6-8 fences 18" in height. Martingales permitted.

#### **Short Stirrup Hunter Division**

Open to riders 10 years and under. To be judged on performance, manners, suitability and soundness.

- 13-14. Short Stirrup Hunter Over Fences To be shown over 8 crossrails 18" in height.
  - 15. Short Stirrup Hunter Under Saddle To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, trot and canter. No martingales.

# Long Stirrup Equitation Division - 17 Years/Under

Open to riders 17 years and under. To be judged 50% on hands and seat and 50% on mount's quietness and suitability.

  Long Stirrup Equitation Under Saddle 17/U To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, trot and canter. No martingales.

# Long Stirrup Hunter Division - 17 Years/Under

Open to riders 17 years and under. To be judged on performance, manners, suitability and soundness.

- 19-20. Long Stirrup Hunter Over Fences To be shown over 8 crossrails 18" in height.
  - 21. Long Stirrup Hunter Under Saddle To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, trot and canter. No martingales.

#### Longer Stirrup Equitation Division - 18 Years/Over (Junior and Amateur Riders Only - No Trainers)

Open to Junior and Amateur riders 18 years and over. To be judged 50% on hands and seat and 50% on mount's quietness and suitability.

- 22. Longer Stirrup Equitation Walk-Trot 18/O To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk and trot. No martingales.
- 23. Longer Stirrup Equitation Under Saddle 18/O To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, trot and canter. No martingales.
- 24. Longer Stirrup Equitation Over Fences 18/O To be shown over 6-8 fences 18" in height. Martingales permitted.

# Longer Stirrup Hunter Division - 18 Years/Over (Junior and Amateur Riders Only - No Trainers)

Open to Junior & Amateur riders 18 years and over. To be judged on performance, manners, suitability and soundness.

- 25-26. Longer Stirrup Hunter Over Fences To be shown over 8 crossrails 18" in height.
  - 27. Longer Stirrup Hunter Under Saddle To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, trot and canter. No martingales.

#### **Crossrail Hunter Division**

Open to horses and ponies. To be judged on performance, manners, suitability and soundness.

- 28-29. Crossrail Hunter Over Fences To be shown over 8 crossrails 18" in height.
  - 30. Crossrail Hunter Under Saddle To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, trot and canter. No martingales.

#### **Open Hunter Crossrail Division**

Open to horses or ponies. To be judged on performance, manners, suitability and soundness.

- 31-32. Open Hunter Crossrail To be shown over 8 crossrails 18" in height.
  - 33. Open Hunter Crossrails Under Saddle To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, trot and canter. No martingales.

#### Pleasure Horse/Pony Division

Open to horses and ponies. To be judged on performance, manners, suitability and soundness. No Martingales.

- 34. Pleasure Horse/Pony Under Saddle To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, trot and canter.
- 35. Pleasure Horse/Pony Combo- To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, trot, canter. To jump 2 fences 2' in height.
- 36. Pleasure Horse/Pony Over Fences To be shown over 8 crossrails 2' in height.

#### **Hopeful Hunter Division**

Open to horses or ponies. To be judged on performance, manners, suitability and soundness.

- 37-38. Hopeful Hunter Over Fences To be shown over 8 crossrails 2' in height.
  - 39. Hopeful Hunter Under Saddle To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, trot and canter. No martingales.

# In order to receive Series End Awards, horse/pony/rider must have shown in 6 or more classes in the division.
