The Budget Committee will present the 2017 Budget at Church Conference on Wednesday, December 14th, at 7:00pm. The budget was handed out on Sunday, November 27th, so you should have time to review it prior to the conference. After discussion on Wednesday, we'll vote at the end of our service on Sunday, December 18th.



Our next "Cookies for Hospice" day will be **Sunday, December 11.** Cookies, and other items were delivered to each of the Hospice homes in November.

On Monday, November 7th we delivered meals to 8 households, which served 11 church members. This was a continuance of our Inward Missions.

A total of 19 shoeboxes were delivered for the Operation Christmas Child shoebox ministry. Please remember to pray for your "child" and his/her family throughout the year. At our November meeting we decided to use some of the WOM funds in the following manner:

- \$200 to the Salvation Army to assist with the North Carolina flood victims
- \$50 to the PMBA office for the purchase of Bible Story books to be given to families receiving toys at the Baptist Toy Store this year
- \$250 for the purchase of toys for boys and girls for the Baptist Toy Store
- \$100 to the Baptist Children's Home in Thomasville to assist with Christmas wishes for the children. (By the way, we found that our donation would be <u>matched</u> during this season through a special foundation earmarked for this purpose).

Please keep in mind the deadline for donating items to the Baptist Toy Store will be Wednesday, November 30th. At our meeting it was also decided to forego our annual soup and salad supper on Wednesday, December 7th due to other meal activities around that date and there will be no WOM meeting that night.

The next WOM meeting will be **January 4**th. With the Baptist Men collecting for the WS Rescue Mission meals, the children collecting coins for the Samaritan Ministries, Senior Moments purchasing livestock for a third world country through the Samaritan's Purse, the WOM with the several projects listed above, the youth sponsoring the Post Office for foreign missions, and the church involved with a *Day at the Kettle* for the Salvation Army, it warms my heart to see how in so many ways "**UNION CROSS REACHES OUT TO SHOW HIS LOVE.**" Blessings to each of you during this upcoming Christmas season. *-Jane Sutphin, WOM President*
