Secretary's Report: Minutes from the May 2022 meeting was read by Mike Wyckoff. Motion was made and minutes were approved.

Treasurer's Report: Cal Roberts reported a savings balance of \$122,937.42 and a checking balance of \$5,610.07. Treasurer's Report was approved.

Membership Report: Mike Wyckoff provided a membership report: 9 Board of Directors, 21 Reduced Rate Members and 298 Social Members for a total of 328 out of the 350 limit. We also have 30 Life Members, 4 Honorary and 7 Jr. for an additional 41 with total of 369.

Mike Wyckoff had 1 new application for membership. A member, Robert Doughty, died in January and his son, Richard Doughty, will take over the membership. Final approval was voted on and approved by the membership. The new member was welcomed by the President.

Dan Charles reported Youth Shooting has been completed for the year. Since this program was started by the club, 325 children have taken advantage of it. Classes will be starting again in October. He also reported Youth Archery has been completed. Since it started in January, 38 children have attended the sessions. Youth Archery will start again next January.

Mike Sabat reported Smallbore Shooting is done for the year. Cal Roberts was recognized by the league with the President's Award. Rachel Sabat was recognized as the Most Improved Shooter.

Tony McClure gave an update on Ladies Night saying the last session had 9 attendees. The last session is June 21st.

County League Reps talked about the Youth Day in Midland on July 16th. Age limit is 8-17. There will be Door Prizes and 10 stations for hunting, fishing and trapping events.
