

## HORTICULTURE

**All exhibits must be left on display until 5:00 p.m. on Sunday.**

***See Rule 34 in the Fair Rules and Regulations regarding vehicles on the fairgrounds.***

**Exhibitors are required to pick up their entries between 5:00 p.m. - 8:00 p.m. Sunday.**

**Any unclaimed items will be discarded during clean-up unless prior arrangements have been made.**

### Open to York, Sunbury, Queens, Kings and Saint John Counties Only

1. Select medium-sized vegetables which are true to type. They should be uniform in size, shape and colour, and free from insect, disease or mechanical injury.
2. Brush the soil off the vegetable; but do not scrub them, as this may cause bruising or skinning.
3. Extra large vegetables or freaks should not be exhibited unless there is a special for them.
4. Cut the tops off the carrots, parsnips and beets. They should be cut so as to leave about one inch of the leaf stalk.
5. It is a good idea to wrap each vegetable in paper to prevent bruising on the way to the Exhibition.
