The ballpark cost of a 250-bed jail, as well as construction of an elevator and pathway near the rear of the courthouse to convey prisoners to courtrooms, could range from about \$20.6 million to \$28.7 million.

'Judge Wesley Brown',

Judge Brown was appointed as a federal district judge in 1962 by then-President John F. Kennedy. It was not until March 2011 that Brown removed himself from the draw for assignment of new criminal case, and by the time he died he was no longer presiding over hearings. Judge Brown died at 104, the oldest fed. Judge.

A very popular story - man made a big foot print for himself! Seems the news was extremely wide spread n well reported! I had book marked the story to share in newsletter when I received this note:

'I saw this on the KU sports site. Quite a guy. I remember when I was a kid, my Dad would talk about him and very favorably so even though he, Judge Brown, was a Democrat:). Within short time - same afternoon I received Cc'd notes generated by John's initial note, that others remembered him or saw same or similar articles in their local newspapers from FL, to NY & CA as well as Hutch n Wichita of course as was generated by AP out of Wichita. Judge Brown was from Hutchinson originally, worked, lived & died in Wichita.

It's obvious that the man left a huge foot print & will be remembered kindly. What a legacy!
