Dessert Donations & Help with Preparation of the Thanksgiving Dinner



School Closing Reminder

In case of stormy weather, keep your radio tuned to WBEV (AM 1430), WXRO (FM 95.3), WTTN (AM 1580), WMDC (FM 98,7), WTMJ (AM 620), WISC (TV-3), WTMJ (TV-4), WITI(TV-6), or WISN (TV-12) for the closing of school or early dismissal. Since many of our students ride the bus, normally our school closes when the local public school closes. When it is announced that Dodgeland is closed due to inclement weather, this means St. John's is included as part of the Dodgeland announcement. Note this for early dismissals and late starts. Mrs. Leissring has compiled an email listing of all of our school families. In the event of an early release, late start, or school closing, she will send out an email using this listing.

News from Lakeside


