Help

Judges 6:1-6

The entire book of Joshua is about a godly man, and it is full of God's people being victorious battle after battle. That changes quickly in the next book, Judges. The opening line? "The Israelites did evil in the eyes of the Lord"...and it only gets worse from there. What do we do when we realize that we've made a mess of life?

Ask God for help! But will he listen?

Aug 11

Hearing

Judges 6:7-10

He listened! As usual in the Old Testament, God sent a prophet to get his response out to his people. His response? Our greatest fear when we know we're guilty: a list of all we've done wrong. (Yuck!) Still, in the middle of God's angry-parent outrage, he also slides in something we've forgotten along the way...if God delivered us in the past, good chance he'll do the same today or tomorrow, too!

Aug 18

Huh-uh!

Judges 6:11-13

God sends a prophet to his people reminding them of their sin. Now, God sends his Son to one specific man to let him know there's hope! Gideon's response? "Huh-uh!" The problem? The way God sees Gideon isn't the way Gideon sees himself. Also, Gideon blames one person alone for all the suffering his people have faced: God. So, no thanks, God!

Aug 25

How?

Judges 6:14-16

Since God isn't in the habit of taking no for an answer, Jesus again tells Gideon that he has big plans for the nation. Through Gideon, specifically. That leads our unlikely hero asking the same thing we've asked of God more than once when we think our Lord has an opportunity of a lifetime for us: how???

Some changes are coming to the youth ministry in the next few months. Please be praying for the leaders of the church and those in youth ministry.

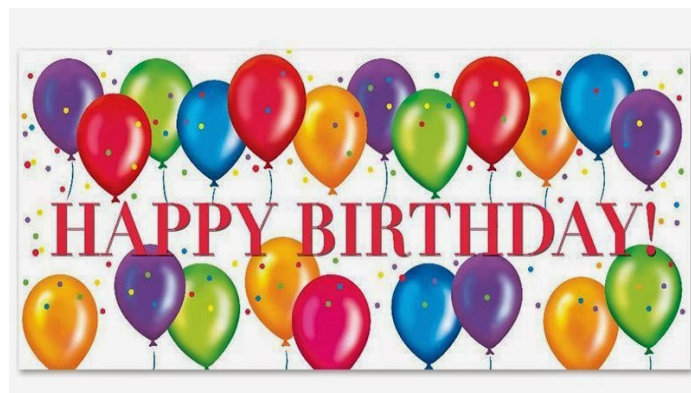
Being an Example of God's Love!
