



**SCHOOL BOARD NEWS**

These are the **UNOFFICIAL DRAFT MINUTES SUBJECT TO CHANGE AND BOARD APPROVAL**, 2-6-102,104 MCA of the September 9, 2019 Regular Meeting:

- Chairman Jesse Cole called the meeting to order at 8:00 p.m. Roll was taken and it was established that a quorum was present.
- Patrons and visitors were recognized.
- On motion by Matt Stentoft, seconded by Leif Handran, the minutes from the August 12, 2019 Annual Budget Meeting, August 12, 2019 Regular Meeting and August 19, 2019 Special Meeting were approved unanimously as presented.
- The Principal and Superintendent reports were discussed and are attached and made a part of these minutes by reference.

**New Business:**

- On motion by Tim Tande, seconded by Matt Stentoft, Claims #16370-16401 dated August 8, 2019 – August 31, 2019, in the amount of \$26,486.93, were approved unanimously as presented.
- On motion by Tim Tande, seconded by Leif Handran, the Activities Report for August 2019, was approved unanimously as presented.
- In order to accommodate students who were presenting information on two action items, Chairman Cole moved the Action item #11 - Sunday Waiver for activity and #12 – Graduation Date to the next part of the meeting.
- Leif Handran moved to waive Spartan Standards policy and allow Honor Society to hold a Chapter Service project on Sunday, September 15, 2019. Matt Stentoft seconded and all present voted in favor.
- Matt Stentoft moved to set the Graduation date for the 2019-2020 school year to May 30, 2019 at 2:00 p.m. Tim Tande seconded and all present voted in favor.
- The next item on the agenda was interviews of potential candidates for the vacant Trustee position after the resignation of Don Hagan. This is to fill the position until the May 2020 election, at which time the candidate may run for the remainder of the vacated term. Two candidates submitted letters of interest. One candidate withdrew their letter. The board then allowed time for discussion with the remaining candidate. Tim Tande moved to appoint DuWayne Wilson to fill the vacant Scobey School Board trustee position for a one year term. Matt Stentoft seconded with Jesse Cole, Tim Tande, Leif Handran and Matt Stentoft all voting Aye, motion passed.
- Joan Bjarko issued the Oath of Office and DuWayne Wilson joined the meeting. The Board reorganized the following committees:

- Leif Handran moved to include Marjorie Hersel, pending background check and Dani Urdahl on the Substitute list for the 2019-2020 school year. Tim Tande seconded and all present voted in favor.
- Tim Tande moved to re-approve the following contracts which had expired: Nancy Linnell, K-3 Music; Autumn Posey – 7-12 Title Paraprofessional; Dawn King – Jr. High Girls Volleyball coach, and Betsy Kilgore – Jr. High & High School cross country co-coach. Matt Stentoft seconded and all present voted in favor.
- Leif Handran moved to accept the following staff resignations – Gracia Lapke at the end of the 2019-2020 school year, and Cris Larson. Tim Tande seconded and all present voted in favor.
- The Boys Basketball co-op with Opheim School for the 2019-2020; 2020-2021 and 2021-2022 Boys Basketball seasons was presented. Tim Tande moved to approve the presented Opheim basketball Co-op agreement. Matt Stentoft seconded and all present voted in favor.
- Matt Stentoft moved to approve the signature on the certification page on Delivering Local Assistance Grant applications as presented. Leif Handran seconded and all present voted in favor.
- Leif Handran moved to resolve that the following list of items, which are the property of School District No. 1, have become abandoned, obsolete, undesirable or unsuitable for the purposes of the district, and to consider the adoption of a resolution to authorize the sale or disposition of such property:
