NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING REGARDING AMENDMENTS TO THE LAKE COUNTY FOOD AND BEVERAGE ORDINANCE #7

Notice is hereby given that the Lake County Board of Commissioners will conduct a public hearing on **March 12, 2019, at 2:30 p.m. in the Lake County Service Center, 616 Third Avenue, Two Harbors, Minnesota** for the purpose of considering proposed amendments to Lake County Food and Beverage Ordinance #7. All interested persons are invited to attend the public hearing to give input. Written comments may also be submitted to the Lake County Administrator's Office, 616 Third Avenue, Two Harbors, MN 55616 prior to the hearing.

IN SUMMARY, THE PROPOSED AMENDMENTS WOULD:

- Adopt and conform to the new Minnesota Food Code (Minnesota Rules Chapter 4626), which became effective January 1, 2019;
- Add the following new local requirements (not included in the Minnesota Food Code):
 - Certified Food Protection Manager must be on duty during all hours of operation, as well as at special events;
 - Hot water must be available at hand sinks used by employees;
 - Minnesota Food Code and Lake County Food and Beverage Ordinance must be available and accessible by employees;
 - Allow for an additional fee if an establishment makes extensive changes after plan review has been submitted;
 - Define terms that were previously not defined; and
 - Clarify language and correct grammar and punctuation

2019 WolfTrack Classic Sled Dog Race

The 11th annual WolfTrack Classic Sled Dog Race is scheduled for February 23rd and 24th. The race is a mid-distance race with two classes: a 30 mile 6 dog race and a 50 mile 8 dog race. The race starts and finishes at the Ely Softball Complex on Old Airport Rd. on Sunday Feb. 24. Teams arrive around 7:00 am that morning for vet checks and race preparation.

A festive atmosphere will fill the air on Saturday, Feb. 23 as musher trucks arrive in Ely. You can meet the mushers at their pre-race spaghetti dinner at 5:00 pm Saturday. The spaghetti dinner is a fund raiser for the Vermillion Community College Wilderness Club, where all the proceeds will go to benefit the club.

Stick around after for the race report, bib presentations and trail conditions report.

The public is invited and encouraged to come watch and share in the pre-race excitement of the dogs. The first team leaves the Ely start line on Sunday at 9:00 am sharp! Each team will leave at two minute intervals until all teams are on the course.

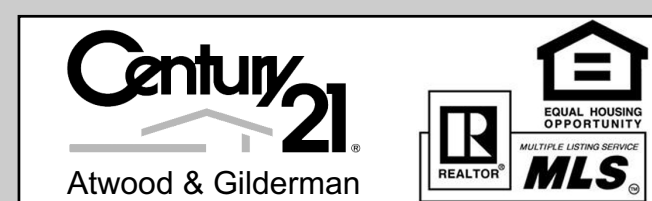
The race follows the Taconite trail through Bear Head State Park, the Fishing Lakes Trail, crosses Bear Head Lake, and comes by the Bear Head Shelter House heading back to Ely. It is a beautiful trail through the Superior National Forest with some challenging terrain. There are some great viewing spots to check the progress of your favorite team, including Hwy 1, Hwy 21 and Bear Head State Park. (You will need a park sticker if you plan to enter the park to watch the race from there.)

A popular stop during the race is the all day event at the Grand Ely Lodge. A special musher menu is available, you can sign up for door prizes, and there are plenty of activities for the kids. You can even keep warm and watch the progress of the teams at the lodge and have plenty of time to get back to the finish line as the teams return.

Once all the teams have finished the race, everyone will gather at the Grand Ely Lodge for great food and the presentation of the awards.
