

THANKSGIVING COCKTAIL

¹/₂ C. ice, or as desired 6 oz. cranberry juice cocktail, chilled 2 oz. vodka

INSTRUCTIONS:

Fill a tall glass with ice; add cranberry juice, vodka and top with soda. Garnish drink with a lime wedge.



TURKEY SAUSAGE AND GRAVY WITH BISCUITS

A great break fast made with Thanksgiving leftovers.

INGREDIENTS:

1 lb. leftover turkey
3 T. freshly chopped sage leaves salt & pepper, to taste
2 T. unsalted butter
3 T. all-purpose flour
2 cups whole milk
biscuits for serving
1 t. salt and
1/2 t pepper



INSRUCTIONS:

Grind turkey into burger.

In a large mixing bowl add the turkey, sage, salt and pepper to taste and mix until combined.

Add the turkey mixture to a medium saucepan over medium heat. Break up into small pieces, heat until turkey is completely warmed up.

Add butter and when it is melted add the flour and stir until well combined.

Slowly stir in the milk. Reduce heat to medium-low and simmer, stirring often, until thickened to desired consistency. Add extra salt and pepper to taste.

Serve on top of leftover biscuits with farm fresh eggs.

LEFTOVER TURKEY MEATLOAF

Another great use for Thanksgiving leftovers.

INGREDIENTS:

2 1/2 pounds leftover turkey 1 1/2 cups leftover stuffing 2 eggs

1/4 C. milk

INSTRUCTIONS:

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Grind turkey into burger. Mix together turkey, stuffing, eggs, and milk in a large bowl. Mixture will be lumpy.

Spread in a greased 9x5 inch loaf pan.



Bake until temperature reads 165 degrees in center of loaf. Serve with leftover mashed potatoes and gravy and your favorite vegetable or side salad.
